



IdahoSTARS QRIS STAR Rating Scale – Group Child Care

The maximum number of points on the STAR Rating Scale is 50.

The IdahoSTARS QRIS uses a *composite scoring system*, meaning that minimum standards are set for earning 1 or 5 stars, and facilities are free to accumulate more points in the standards as they see fit.

In order to earn 1 STAR (or higher), a facility must earn at least 12 points by meeting all of the Tier 1 requirements. 12 points represents at least one point in each Quality Standard, depending on the facility type.

In order to earn 5 STARS, a facility must meet all requirements in Tiers 1 - 3 and earn at least 41 points.

Group Child Care point scale:

- 12 points = 1 star
- 13-21 points = 2 star
- 22-30 points = 3 star
- 31-40 points = 4 star
- 41-50 points = 5 star
